

**KNIFE CRAFTERS HOST WINTER SHOW**

**Pretoria, 19 July 2012.** Several knife crafters will host a winter knife show on 27 and 28 July 2012 in the Voortrekker hall on the picnic site at the Voortrekker Monument. Unique, hand-made knives will be on show. About 40 exceptional knives with the rhino as theme will be auctioned off on the evening of the 27th of July. The proceeds of the auction are in aid of the Pilanesberg Trust.

The show times are as follows:

- Friday 27 July 2012 from 12:00 to 18:00 (after which the auction)
- Saturday 28 July 2012 from 09:00 to 17:00

Information, products and machinery for knife crafters and aspiring knife crafters will be on sale. There will also be two interesting exhibits: The family of Harry Wolhuter, one of the first game rangers in SA, have made his exhibition available for the show, and an exhibit by Andrew Jackson – currently the Chief Executive Officer of the Pilansberg Nature Trust, concerning the conservation of rhino's.

The entrance fee is R30.00 for adults but pensioners and primary school children are free. A site fee of R10 is payable at the gate in aid of the Voortrekker Monument. Light meals, refreshments and safe parking are available as well as entertainment for the children. Braai areas are available at the picnic site and visitors can come and make a day of it.
