WELL KNOWN WAR STORE NOW IN PRETORIA

Pretoria, 7 February 2012. The well known *War Store* which has been operating from the Ditsong National Military History Museum in Johannesburg for the past ten years is now in Pretoria. The new shop is situated in Fort Schanskop on the Voortrekker Monument Heritage Site. The shop fits in well with the old Anglo-Boer War fort which was built to protect Pretoria in 1896.

The shop supplies historically correct clothing to collectors, the film industry and veterans. It has original as well as reproduction clothing from the Zulu wars as well as the Anglo-Boer War, the First and Second World War and Korea up to the current conflict in Afghanistan and Iraq. The shop buys and sells items such as uniforms, medals, badges, de-activated vintage weapons and knives.

The *War Store* is always on the lookout for militaria to purchase and readily buys such items. Alan, the owner of the shop, will be at the shop every Saturday until 16:00 to evaluate or purchase any militaria. In future there will also be a small military fair at Fort Schanskop on the days that the antique and collectors fair takes place at the Monument.
