

ANTIQUA MARKET GETS OWN ATM

Pretoria, 7 March 2017. The first of the four very popular antique and collectable markets that take place annually at Voortrekker Monument, takes place on 21 March from 09:00 to 15:00 on the roof of the large amphitheatre. The entrance fee to the market is R30 per car but please note that no visitors to the market will be allowed access to the site before 07:00.

The market, which is now in its eleventh year, is thought to be the best in the country and applications for stalls is high. Unfortunately stalls are not easy to acquire as exhibitors do not relinquish their stalls easily. There are 171 stalls at the market selling a huge variety of goods such as old enamelware, coins, beautiful porcelain, Dinky Toys, dining services, knives, jewellery, glassware and much more. Because of a huge demand, the Monument has acquired a mobile ATM from FNB for the markets. Hopefully no one will have to leave the market now without acquiring that must have item.

There is a restaurant and several food stalls at the market, as well as parking for people with wheelchairs.
