Pretoria, 11 September 2017. Because Heritage Day falls on a Sunday this year, the last antique and collectables fair at the Voortrekker Monument will take place on Monday, 25 September. It runs from 09:00 to 15:00 on the roof of the large amphitheatre on the Voortrekker Monument heritage site. Please note that visitors to the market will not be allowed access to the site before 07:00. The entrance fee is R30 per car. Come early because Christmas is just around the corner and this is the last market of the year. As a result of the building activities on our picnic site the heritage day festival will not coincide with the antique fair this year.

We have a new trader at the market who will be selling a lifetime's worth of beautiful things from Japan. Visitors can look forward to a huge variety of goods such as old enamelware, coins, beautiful porcelain, dolls, dining services, knives, jewellery, glassware and a whole lot more. The FNB ATM will also be available for visitors with an urge to spend.

There is a restaurant and several food stalls at the market, as well as parking and access for visitors with wheelchairs. Visitors should please leave their dogs and other pets at home as the Monument is situated in a nature reserve and dogs or other pets are not allowed on site.
